From Austria to Hollywood, WWII, torpedoes, ecstasy, and intrigue to the very cell phone in your pocket, she was there!

Heather Massie will star as Hedy Lamarr. Ms. Massie previously performed in Harrisburg with Gamut Theatre Group's Harrisburg Shakespeare Company as Celia in As You Like It, Ophelia in Hamlet, and Maria in Love's Labour's Lost; and with Gamut's Stage Door Series as Helen of Troy and Gordy Lear in As She Likes It. Having studied Astrophysics with dreams of becoming an astronaut, Heather Massie marries her loves of art and science in the person of Hedy Lamarr. Known as 'The Most Beautiful Woman in the World', Hedy Lamarr stored away knowledge of munitions while married to Austrian arms dealer, Fritz Mandl. She employed this knowledge to support the US Navy's war effort during WWII by inventing The Secret Communication System with composer George Antheil, to make torpedoes more accurate. Also referred to as Frequency Hopping or Spread Spectrum Technology, her invention is used today in cell phones, WiFi, CDMA, GPS, Bluetooth, military satellites, and a myriad of other wireless systems.

HEDY! The Life & Inventions of Hedy Lamarr has appeal for all audiences, with special interest for Immigrant, Austrian, Jewish, Film, History, Scientific, Wireless Communication, Military, Theatre, and LGBTQ Communities, as well as teenagers, adults, and retirees. It is suitable for audiences ages 12 and up. The script was developed in the Artist-in-Residence Program in 2016 at the Grange Hall Cultural Center in Waterbury Center, VT, and performed there in March 2017. It was presented in DivaFest 2017 in Indianapolis in March 2017; and is slated to perform in the 2017 Planet Connections Theatre Festivity in NYC, June 18-30; in a Special Performance at The Stags Head in Dublin, Ireland, July 17; in the 2017 Galway Fringe in Galway, Ireland, July 21-29; in IndyFringe 2017, August 23-27 in Indianapolis, IN; and in the 2017 Intwasa Arts Festival in Bulawayo, Zimbabwe in September.
